AUTONOMY AND SOCIAL SKILLS

Draw a dimensional picture of a person
Demonstrate observable listening behaviors
Ask appropriately for the help of an adult when needed
Offer assistance to another child
Accept consequences of actions
Care for personal needs by dressing oneself independently

Identify and follow classroom rules
Respect the personal belongings and property of others
Take turns using toys and sharing materials
Attempt to solve problems or conflict using words
Carry out chores that contribute to the well-being and functioning of the group

WORK HABITS

Memorize address, phone number, date of birth
Carry out multi-step oral directions that have been accompanied by a preliminary demonstration
Choose and use a toy or activity independently for a sustained period of time

Return toys and materials to their proper location
Work in an orderly, persistent fashion in completing a task even if difficulty is encountered

CHILDREN'S LITERATURE, NURSERY RHYMES, POEMS, FINGER PLAYS, AND SONGS

Memorize and recite independently a simple nursery rhyme, poem or song
Sequence illustrations of 3 -5 story events

Attend and listen to picture books with story lines as well as books of other genres, such as non-fiction

ORAL LANGUAGE

Identify opposites
Name/Point to circle, square, triangle, and rectangle

Name/Point to parts of the body

EMERGING LITERACY SKILLS IN READING AND WRITING

Give the sounds of at least 3 letters of the alphabet
Identify at least 20 upper case letters and 20 lower case letters
Draw and use as motifs: horizontal line, vertical line, diagonal line, zigzag line, circle, spiral, moon, cross, cane, hook, bowl, bridge, wave, X, star

Given a word, provide other rhyming words
Hold a writing instrument correctly between the thumb and index finger, resting against the middle finger

MOVEMENT AND COORDINATION

Maintain balance walking forward, backward and sideways on a balance beam (10" wide or less)
Play catch using a large ball with a partner seated or standing 2 1/2 ft. apart

Play group games such as Duck Duck Goose, Drop the Handkerchief, Kitty Wants a Corner, Musical Chairs, Red Light Green Light, Relay Race, Tag

MATHEMATICAL REASONING AND NUMBER SENSE

Classify several groups of objects or pictures
Recite the number sequence 1-10
Identify pairs of objects or pictures as the same or different
Organize and read a simple bar graph

Continue a complex, pattern made up of two components
Name and write numerals 1-10
Count groups of objects with up to 10 items per group
