Computer

Grammar

- 1 Composition notebook

Literature/Vocabulary

- 1 Composition notebook or subject notebook

Math

- 3 subject notebook or 3 sections in a binder

Religion

- 2 Pocket folder

Science

- Medium size 3 ring binder
- Filler paper with dividers

Social Studies

- 3 subject notebook or 3 sections in a binder

Spanish

- Spanish English Dictionary & 3 subject notebook

Library

- 1 pocket folder

For all subjects

- 8 folders with pockets-One for each subject, clearly marked with student's name, homeroom and the subject
- 1000+ - 3 ½ x5 index cards – for flashcards in Spanish, Vocabulary, Social Studies, Grammar and Science.
Optional- container to hold index cards for strong elastic to keep cards together. NOTE= index cards should be kept for the entire year because often they are used to study for the final.
- A supply of blue and black pens
- Pencils
- Personal pencil sharpener
- Highlighters
- A soft pencil case to hold supplies
- One large eraser
- Book covers- cloth book covers or brown paper bag covers are recommended

- Three boxes of tissues, Clorox/Lysol wipes

- It is suggested that all students have a locker organizer
- In the past we have required a different colored folder and notebook for each class. This year it is not required but for many students having a green folder and green notebook for religion and a yellow folder and notebook for Social Studies etc. helps them to stay organized and bring the proper material to the correct class.
- In the past students were required to have a graph notebook for math. If this would help with organization, please feel free to use this kind of notebook.
- Some students do better with a binder rather than notebooks, so students have a choice of one or the other.
- Students will not be allowed to carry backpacks to classes, so the backpack must fit in the locker during the day.
- To help students lighten their load, students do not need their own markers, crayons, tape, glue, and scissors. These supplies will be available in the classroom. Any donations to the classroom will be greatly appreciated.
