- 1 correcting pen (red, green, black or blue) – **REPLACE AS NEEDED**

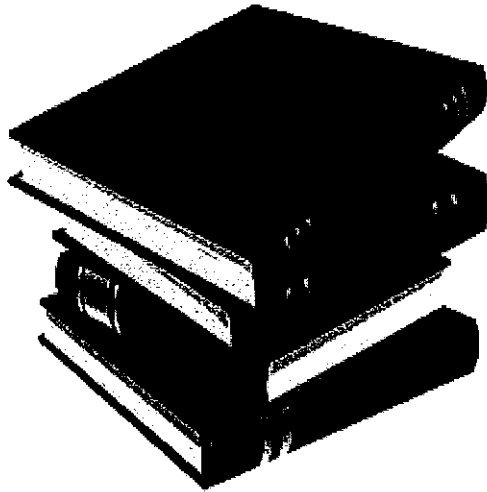
